Bus Album

Al Hannah, Victoria AUS

Projects | Class of '87



KC MATERIALS: BTP: SB2097 School Bus, Class of 87 Paper Collection, Chipboard Alphas, Orange & Yellow Kaisercolour Paint, Tiny White Alphas, Die Cut Elements, Coloured Rubons, Mini Cherry Red Alpha Stickers, Reward Stickers, Tuck Shop Die Cut, Paper Pad, Foam Mounting Tape.

Sand and paint all edges with Yellow Kaisercolour. Don't forget inside the windows.

FRONT COVER: Cover the front page of the bus with *Tuck Shop*. Paint the chipboard letters orange and set aside to dry.

Trim the blocked stripes from the *Sports Day*

sheet and adhere closely to the lower edge of the bus. Apply some alphabet rubons if desired.

Attach three different die cuts in place as shown to sit behind the chipboard title, then adhere title in place.

Adhere tiny white alphas in between the words "wheel" and "bus".

Adhere the mini cherry alpha words "round" as shown to run around the rim of the wheels.

Add a red light using a spot from the *Timetables*

sheet and attach with a foam dot.

For the first open page spread, cover both pages with *Assembly*. Adhere a photograph in place. Do journalling on strips and attach.

For the second open page spread, cover both pages with *Bookweek*. Complete as the first open page spread. Cover the back page of the album with *Tuck Shop*.

To complete wheels, attach sticker "so proud of you" with foam mounting tape.

Tagbox

Al Hannah, Victoria AUS

KC MATERIALS: BTP: SB2026 Tag Box, SB2025 Boyzone Tags, Class of 87 Paper Collection, Red Kaisercolour Paint, Die Cut Elements, Red Alpha Stickers, Chipboard Alphas #2, Tiny White Alphas, Paper Pad, Reward Stickers, Foam Mounting Tape.

OTHER: Bracket Square Punch, Scallop Circle Punch, Scallop Border Punch, Twine.

Paint all sides and edges with Red Kaisercolour. Assemble and glue. Use a large rubber band to hold together while the glue is drying. Cut a 4cm (1 1/2") orange strip from *Science Project* and adhere to lower edge of box.

Cut the blocked stripes from *Sports Day* and adhere to bottom edge.

Cut a scallop border approximately 2cm (3/4") in height from *Assembly* and adhere so it sits just below the edge of the front of the box.

Cut the apple strip from *Assembly* and adhere as shown.



Adhere chipboard numbers on sides as shown. Create tag for the front of the box as shown and add the word "times tables" to complete tag. To create the featured tag, cover with a stripe page from the paper pad. Punch a bracket from *Sports Day*, cut the blue flag from a sheet in the paper pad, and add an apple rubon. Wind some white twine around the green bracket shape and attach to tag with foam mounting tape. Punch a circle of your choice and adhere as shown.

Embellish all other tags as desired, adding the times tables on each tag!





You can do it

Melissa Kennedy, Victoria AUS

KC MATERIALS: Class of '87 Paper Collection, Paper Pad, Stickers, Rubons, Report Cards and Pocket, Chipboard Alpha No. 3, Mini alphas - black. **OTHER:** Distress ink, Dimensional Magic.

Use the Die Cut page *Tuck Shop* as the background for this page. Cut the printed strip from the bottom of *Science Project* and adhere approx. 1" just inside the left edge.

Cut an 18 x 24cm (7" x 9½") rectangle from *Assembly* (reverse) and adhere to the right side of your page 3cm from top edge and 2cm from right. Run the ABC die cut from the paper pad to the top right edge of this sheet. Adhere the *School Yard* page from the paper pad, 4cm from top edge. Matte a photo towards the right side of a green piece from the paper pad and adhere to your page in the lower right corner of the blue piece.

Matte a smaller second photo using blue *Assembly* (reverse) and attach just below the writing "The Schoolyard".

Adhere a few report cards inside the report pocket. Attach another photo to the right side of this mini report pocket overlapping the main photo. Complete this layout by adding additional elements such as stickers or diecut, a title, and journaling.

Whether it be reports, certificates or other collected memorabilia, keep them all together in your album in 'Class of 87's Specialty pocket page. Decorate the front of the pocket with papers to match the main page opposite.

One, two, three

Al Hannah, Victoria AUS

1. Cut a rectangle approximately 14.5x5cm (5 ¾"x2") from *Sports Day* (reverse). Adhere to top of card.
2. Cut another rectangle approximately 14.5x5cm (5 ¾"x2"), scallop the bottom edge and adhere.
3. Cut a strip from the *Sports Day* paper "one two three" and adhere.
4. Cut another thin strip from *Timetables* (reverse) and adhere to cover the "one two three" strip.
5. Stamp a sentiment onto a mini flash card from the *Show & Tell* (reverse) paper. Add a small report card die cut from the paper pad and complete card with the A+ circle.



K is for kinder

KC MATERIALS: Class of '87 Paper Collection, Chipboard Shapes, Embellishment Pack / Chipboard Alphabet # 3, Black ink, Lovely Grosgrain Ribbon, Foam Mounting Dots.
OTHER: Black pen.

Use *Assembly* (reverse) as your background and cut off narrow edging strip.
From *Book Week* (reverse) cut a piece 20cm x 29cm (8" x 11 1/2") and adhere against the lower edge of background, slightly toward the right hand side.
From *Science Project* (reverse) cut a piece 20cm x 21cm (8" x 8 1/2"), scallop edges and adhere against right edge of page, as shown.
Cut the top striped section from *Sports Day* and a narrow strip of *Timetables* (reverse). Scallop the edge of this, then adhere behind the striped piece. Adhere this piece near the bottom of page.

Adhere a 10cm x 15cm (4" x 6") photograph in the top left corner of orange section, and three smaller photographs around its lower left corner, as shown.
Cut the "Kk" box from *Show and Tell* and the "Kinder" tag from *Sports Day*. Adhere, layered, by the small photograph beneath the large one. Adhere inked letters to complete title.
Cut a blue journal box from *Show and Tell* and the narrow edging strip from *Sports Day*, and adhere to the blue 'Report' pocket. Journal on small cards and tuck into pocket.
Use foam dots to adhere a fourth smaller photograph, overlapping pocket and title, then embellish with chipboard shapes and ribbon.

Always proud of you

KC MATERIALS: Class of 87 Paper Collection, Paper Pad, Report Cards and Pockets, Organza Ribbon, Foam Mounting Tape, Tiny White Alphas, Clear Stamps, Coloured Rubons.

Use *Bookweek* (reverse) as the background for this layout.
Cut a 23.5x25.5cm (9 1/4" x 10") piece from *Timetables* and adhere. Add red stitching now if desired.
Cut a 13x13.5cm (5x5 1/4") piece from *Assembly* (reverse). Attach in place as shown.
Add the red apple die cut to the lower right edge. Attach the blue Victorian die cut approximately 10cm (4") from the left edge.
Create a tag to insert into the report card pocket. Adhere pocket in place. Attach the striped Victorian border die cut as shown.

Print three photographs 6.5x9.5cm (2 1/2"x2 3/4") leaving a small white border around the edge of each photo. Attach the three photographs in place as shown.
Cut the alphabet paper strip from *Book Week* and adhere.

To create the banner, cut the triangles from the *Sports Day* sheet. Place string as shown and adhere triangle flags in place with foam mounting tape. Embellish with rubons, clear stamps and finish with a Star Student Award Report Card.

Create your own tag using the back of a report card simply by cutting the top corners of each edge and punching a hole, then adding some coloured paper to finish!

Desk set up

KC MATERIALS: BTP: SB115 Table Tidy, SB110 Ribbon Dispenser, SB2096 Diary, Class of '87 Paper Collection, Stickers, Embellishment Pack / Red Alphabet Stickers, Red Mini Alphas.
OTHER: Icypole Sticks.

These projects are so quick and easy to make that you could even get your child to make one for their desk.

For a more natural look (as pictured) I have left the edges raw, but if you would like to make more of a statement with these projects paint the edges in a bright co-ordinating colours.

Decorate by covering the pieces of these products with your choice of patterned paper.

DIARY: Run strips of coordinating paper down the left sides over the holes. Make sure you punch out the holes before turning over to cover the back of these pieces.

TABLE TIDY: You won't be able to wrap a whole 12" piece of paper around this so you may want to cut out four rectangles of either different or the same papers 8cm x 10cm (3¼" x 4") and adhere to each side.

RIBBON BOX: When you cover the front panel, don't cut out the holes in the front and you have a great box to use for your pencils or texas.

Decorate these projects using a selection of die cuts or printed chipboard, even cut out elements of the designs from other printed papers in the range.

Use the patterned side of the barcode strip from each paper as an added feature strip instead of throwing it away.

Star student hanger

KC MATERIALS: BTP: W419 Ribbon Door Hanger, Class of '87 Paper Collection, Stickers, Embellishment Pack / Red Alphabet Stickers, Red Mini Alphas. **OTHER:** Icypole Sticks.

Cover Ribbon Hanger in *Sports Day* (reverse). Trim excess.

Cut a 4cm (1½") strip of *Book Week* (reverse), then cut into 10cm (4") pieces. (Cut as many as you need) Matte these in pieces of *Timetables* (reverse). Adhere a sticker then use alphabet stickers for names. Adhere an icypole stick behind each, as shown.

Adhere the yellow pocket below the window, with the "Star Student" card over the top. Cut two 5cm (2") circles of *Timetables* (reverse), (here, scalloped) and adhere as shown. Cut three more 3.5cm (1½") circles and adhere stickers to each. Adhere as desired to main piece, then embellish with mini alphas.



Boring to brilliant!

RULER

Use your favourite paper to cover a once boring ruler- wollah! Go as plain or detailed as you want!



COLOURED PENCILS

With school starting again for a new year, help your child make it a colourful one.

Simply cover their school essentials like pencils, rulers, and erasers- anything!

It is a fun project for yourself, or get the kids involved. They will definitely be too cool for school with these brightened up tools!



TEACHER & STUDENT BOOKMARKS

Make your child's reading fun with these simple bookmarks or think about giving it as a personalised, special gift for their classroom teacher. Laminate them for a longer life, and add some ribbon or die cut elements for a bit of colour.

BAG TAGS

Any spare mini album pages lying around your scrap room? Convert your BTP into an awesome bag tag to brighten up any backpack.

Here we have used Scallop Tag Album (SB154), covered it, added die cut elements, ribbon and alpha stickers to make possibly THE best tag in school!

ERASER

Covering erasers, could not be more simple! Use the existing cover as a template, and even add mini alphas with your child's name to personalise. It is also an attractive way to keep your child's belongings cleaner for longer!



Life itself is...

KC MATERIALS: Magic Happens Paper Collection, Journal Tags, Silver Rhinestones, Paper Pad, Chipboard Alphabet, Organza Ribbon, Rubons, Tiny White Alphas, Foam Mounting Tape. **OTHER:** Black Glitter, Fiskars Apron Punch

Use *Fairy Dust* (reverse) as the background for this layout. Cut a rectangle 17x28cm (6 ¾"x11") from *Potion* (reverse), border punch the left edge and adhere in place. Cut another rectangle 24.5x14cm (9 ¾"x5 ½") from *Potion*. Adhere in place. Cut two strips from the *Fairytale & Spirit* pages. Cover the edge of the *Potion* rectangle. Tuck a scallop die cut underneath as shown.

Cut two Victorian shaped borders approximately 14cm (5 ½") from a teal and purple sheet in the paper pad. Trim these in half and position approximately 8cm (3 ¼") from the top and 3.5cm (1 ½") from the right edge. Print one photograph 10.5x15.5cm (4 ¼"x6") and adhere in place. Print three smaller photographs 7.5x7.5cm (3"x3") and adhere as shown. Embellish with a journal tag, title and rubons.

I believe in YOU

KC MATERIALS: Magic Happens.; Sapphire, Fairtale, Paper Pad, Chipboard Alpha's No. 3, **OTHER:** Silver Versa Ink, Shimmerz, Tulle

Use *Sapphire* Die cut page as your background for this layout. Cut a small strip from the striped page in the paper pad and adhere in the upper left corner. Also the paper pad find the page that is gloss varnished with the swirls printed on it. Type up your journalling or as an alternative, find a poem you like. Print this out on this page (First, slightly sand over the top of the gloss varnished swirls first to allow the ink from the printer to stay on the page). Once this has been printed, overlay over the striped piece and adhere a small rectangle cut from *Fairytale* under the bottom right corner. Attach these pieces to the background. Cut a small die cut border strip from the paper pad in half and lay across these towards the bottom edge. Slightly colour with an ink pad a small paper doilie and adhere to the left side of the square piece. Matte photo using the small violet poka dot page (also from the paper pad) and adhere on the left side of your layout. Add a die cut to the lower right corner of your photograph using foam tape. Use Silver ink to colour your chipboard letters and adhere in position.

To add dimension, gather some tulle and adhere to your photograph. Here I have added the remaining die cut used earlier.

Once upon a time...

KC MATERIALS: Magic Happens Paper Collection, Coloured Rubons / Blue Organza Ribbon, Small Lowercase Chipboard Letters, Frames Wooden Flourishes, Metallic Silver Kaisercolour, White Pearl Flourish, Snow Pearls, White Tiny Alphas.

Use *Fairy Tale* as your background and cut off narrow edging strip. Using a craft knife, cut around the first two spires of the castle.

From *Pixie*, cut a piece 27cm x 17cm (10 ½" x 6 ½") and adhere against the top edge of background, slipping corner under the castle. From the reverse leftovers, cut a wide purple patterned stripe. Cut the specialty diecut paper to roughly 20cm x 21cm (8" x 8 ½"), and adhere over the *Pixie* piece. Cut a 15cm (6") circle of *Spirit* (reverse) and adhere overlapping both pieces, as shown, with a 10cm x 15cm (4" x 6") photograph layered on top. Cut the purple stripe to 17cm (6 ½"), and tie short lengths of ribbon at intervals. Adhere along left edge of photograph.

Paint the small oval frame silver, and adhere a small piece of *Spirit* (reverse) behind it. Adhere to lower right corner of photograph, with an initial inside.

Journal around and below photograph with tiny alpha stickers and embellish with coloured rubons, pearls and pearl flourishes.



Secret Mini Chest

KC MATERIALS: BTP: SB2088 Chest of Drawers, Magic Happens PaperCollection, Lilac Rhinestone Strips, Lilac Rhinestones, Magical Butterflies, Mauve Kaisercolour.

Paint the sides and edges of all the project pieces with the exception of the ones you plan on covering with paper.

Cover one side of the back piece using *Pixie*.

Cover the two bookshelf outside edges using *Fairydust*, making sure you carefully place the fairy towards the bottom of one of the pieces - facing outwards.

Cover the top shelf using the remainder of the *Pixie* paper.

Cut 3 rectangles 15cm x 5cm (6" x 2") from a selection of individual papers or paper pad.

Embellish the bookshelf to complete by adhering lilac Rhinestone Strips to the edges of the shelves and individual rhinestones to the wings of the butterfly.

Make sure you paint the cardboard boxes on both sides and allow to dry. This will enable you to save paper and only have to cover the front side of each drawer with paper.

Fairy castle

KC MATERIALS: BTP: SB186 Fairy Castle Album, Magic Happens Paper Collection, Coloured Rubons, Paper Pad, Silver Rhinestone Strips, Mauve Kaisercolour, Chipboard Alpha's No. 3, Foam Tape
OTHER: Twinklets Diamond Dust, White Gel Pen, Sky Blue Brilliance Ink Pad

Paint the edges of your album pieces using mauve Kaisercolour and allow to dry.

Choose a selection of papers from the range and work out what order you would like to adhere them to on your pages.

Prior to covering the back of the front cover, use a white gel pen to draw a grid pattern on some scraps and adhere behind the cutout windows.

When all pages are covered draw some scallop shapes on the roof tops and then go over with a glue pen.

Sprinkle some fairy dust - glass flakes over the glue and shake off excess allow to dry.

Cut a few small strips from the striped page of the paper pad that use the silver foil and adhere under the roofline.

Fill your album with gorgeous pictures of your little cherubs or a selection of your favourite quotes as I have done.

Use silver rhinestones strips to complete and adhere around the door and top window.

Bracket frame

Melissa Kennedy, Victoria AUS

KC MATERIALS: BTP: SB2101 Bracket Frame, Magic Happens - Sapphire Die cut Page, Silver Rhinestone Strips, Silver Rhinestones, Magical Butterflies, Mauve Kaisercolour, Paper Bloom: Amethyst, Seabreeze, Flowers: Snow, Baby Blue and Lavender.

OTHER: Twinklets Diamond Dust.

Paint the edges and back of the frame using the mauve Kaisercolour and allow to dry. Because the inside cut out of the frame is rounded you will need to cut the square out of the paper you have chosen.

From *Sapphire* cut a 17.2 cm (6¾") square and slightly round the four edges. Adhere to your frame and use a brayer to remove any air bubbles if needed.

Print out a quote onto the centre of a page from the paper pad and adhere to the additional backing piece of wood. Attach this to the back of your frame.

Adhere silver rhinestone strips around the inside edge of your frame. Decorate to complete with a butterfly and clusters of flowers.

Mirror, mirror...

Al Hannah, Victoria AUS

KC MATERIALS: BTP: W129 Mirror, Purple Kaisercolour Paint, Elegant Pearl Flourish, Fairy Specialty Glitter Paper, Papper Pad, Paper Blooms Flowers Amethyst, Wooden Frames, Chipboard Alpha # 3, Foam Mounting Tape.

OTHER: Glass Finish

Take mirror out before painting. Paint all edges and the back of the mirror. Set aside to dry.

Cover the frame with *Pixie*. (To position your paper on the frame, hold your sheet in front of the frame in good light). Sand edges to neaten

Paint the title and the Wooden Flourish frame with purple Kaisercolour. Add glass finish to the title if desired.

Cut out a glittery fairy and butterfly.

Print out a quote on a sheet from the paper pad to insert behind the flourish frame, and trim to the shape of the frame.

Position everything in place. When you are happy with placement, adhere to complete.





Creative Cards

Al Hannah & Melissa Kennedy, Victoria AUS

a. Hope today is special...

KC MATERIALS: KC White Cards, Paper Pad, Organza, Butterfly Wooden Flourish, Foam Mounting Tape **OTHER:** Border Punch, Ink

1. Cut a rectangle 9.5x5cm (3 7/8"x2") from the silver foil butterfly sheet in the paper pad. Adhere approximately 1cm (3/8") from the left edge, and 6.5cm (2 1/2") from the top edge.
2. Cut a strip 9.5cm (3 7/8") from the blue star sheet in the paper pad and border punch. Adhere just below the rectangle.
3. Adhere the flower border die cut in place down the left edge of the card. Stamp a sentiment onto the pink die cut and adhere with foam mounting tape.
4. Ink the wooden butterfly and adhere as shown.
5. Finish with a blue organza bow and a glittered butterfly.

b. Little Princess

KC MATERIALS: KC Lilac Cards, Fairytale (reverse) Sheet, Paper Pad, Chipboard Embellishments, Rubons, Paper Pad, Rhinestone Strips, Organza Ribbon, Foam Mounting Tape **OTHER:** Butterfly Punch, Scallop Circle.

1. Adhere the purple scallop border closely to the bottom edge of the card.
2. Cut a strip 14.5x3.5cm (5 7/8"x1 1/4") from *Fairytale* (reverse) and adhere above scallop border.
3. Cut a silver foil strip from the paper pad sheet and adhere to cover the top of the dotted piece.
4. Adhere a purple scallop circle and add the "make a wish" die cut with foam mounting tape. Adhere a ribbon.
5. Adhere the chipboard fairy with foam mounting tape.
6. Finish with the rubons, small butterfly and rhinestone strip.

c. I Believe in Fairies

KC MATERIALS: Magic Happens Paper Collectin, Paper Pad, Die Cut Elements, Paper Blooms Flowers Amethyst and White, Rubons, Foam Mounting Tape, KC Sky Blue Cards. **OTHER:** Butterfly Punch.

1. Cut a rectangle 10.5x14.5cm (4x5 3/4") from the paper pad. Adhere a strip of purple dots from the paper pad approximately 14.5x2.5cm (5 3/4"x1") and adhere.
2. Adhere the Victorian border die cut from the paper pad approximately 2.5cm (1") from the

- left edge. If desired, sew a straight stitch border around the entire rectangle as shown.
3. Attach a thin teal foil strip to cover the join of the Victorian border.
4. Apply a rubon to a die cut element and adhere with foam mounting tape.
5. Embellish with blooms paper flowers and a butterfly.

d. You're Simply the Best

KC MATERIALS: Magic Happens Paper Collection, Paper Pad, Rubons, Foam Mounting Tape, Mini Clear Stamps "Thank You", KC Soft Pink Cards **OTHER:** Border Punch, Rectangle shaped punch

1. Cut a rectangle 14.5x10.5cm (5 3/4"x4") from the paper pad. Adhere.
2. Punch a border 10.5cm (4") long. Adhere in place.
3. Cut a strip from the foil page of strips in the paper pad 10.5cm (4") long.
4. Adhere the oval fairy die cut in place.
5. Stamp the clear stamp sentiment on the punched rectangle and adhere with foam mounting tape to finish.
